## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- 1) USBC tournament rules will prevail. No smoking or drinking alcoholic beverages while in the tournament building. Appropriate attire required, no hats/caps/headphones or clothing with inappropriate language, messages, slogans, or pictures allowed. Anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not participate. All pants will be worn at waist level with no underwear or bare skin showing. Shorts must be at least mid-thigh in length. No tobacco or alcohol advertising on clothes or bowling equipment. Bowlers with inappropriate clothing will change their attire to conform to the rules or they will not bowl.
- 2) Eligibility is limited to current members of the Space Coast USBC BA (Adult & Youth).
- This tournament will be conducted on an age basis of two (2) divisions, REGARDLESS OF AVERAGE, breakdown for ages as follows:
  - 1: Adult with Youth 12 & OVER, 2: Adult with Youth 11 & UNDER. Handicap in all divisions will be 90% of 210.
- 4) Entering Averages: The entering average shall be the bowler's highest 2020-2021 league average of 12 games (Youth) and 21 games (Adult) or more as of July 31, 2021. Bowlers not having an average as specified above will use a current average of 12 games (Youth) and 21 games (Adult) or more at the time of bowling. Bowlers with neither of these averages will use a summer 2021 average of 21 games. Bowlers not having any of these averages will bowl SCRATCH. It is the responsibility of the Bowlers to certify and provide the Tournament Manager with eligible averages. Send eligible averages with entry form and late averages 1 week before bowling. Only Space Coast B.A. USBC Adult and Youth averages may be used.
- 5) This tournament shall consist of 1 event for both divisions. All participants will bowl three games.
- Partners shall consist of two bowlers. Doubles may consist of any combination of Male/Boys; Males/Girls, Females/Boys, Females/Girls. Each bowler may bowl in Doubles events twice as long there is a partner change. A bowler may bowl more than once. Highest scores in each division will be the winners of those events. Bowlers can only CASH once.
- 7) ALL ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED OR DELIVERED TO THE TOURNAMENT MANAGER BY THE ENTRY CLOSE DATE. **No entry accepted without the entry fee** (MONEY ORDER, CHECK, CERTIFIED CHECK OR CENTER CHECK ONLY). *Make checks payable to:* Space Coast USBC BA
- 8) Bowlers will bowl in the order listed on the entry form. Change in the computer line-up not allowed. Substitutes are allowed and will bowl in the same line-up position.
- 9) All entrants must report at least 30 minutes before squad time. If any changes or substitutions, the Team Captain must report to the Tournament Manager at least 45 minutes before squad time.
- 10) Team Captains must sign the entry form for verification of line-up.
- Scholarships shall be awarded in each division for each youth bowlers, Adults will be awarded cash prizes. Events are based on one scholarship per 5 entries. There will be scholarships for boys and girls in both divisions. In case of a tie for first place duplicate awards will be given and co-champions declared. Cash and Scholarship fund returned 100%.
- Report any appeal or protest regarding scores or eligibility to the Tournament Manager or Director IN WRITING within 72 hours after any error or infraction has occurred.
- Any bowler arriving after the squad has started bowling will begin in the frame being bowled. No score(s) recorded for the frame(s) missed.
- 14) ONLY TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS are allowed to correct scoring errors. TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS OR AUTHORIZED VOLUNTEERS will record scores on Official Recap sheets.
- 15) All Bowlers will be expected to comply with current Facility, City, County, State, Federal and CDC guidelines regarding COVID-19.
